The Beginning

First problem: 2000 kidnappings for ransom of Olsztyn businessmen and their families

Favourable factors: petty approach of law enforcement authorities and increase of the scale of the problem

Approach: cooperation with the best law firms in Poland, ensuring factual media coverage of trials and publication of verdicts

Achievement of goal: kidnappings stopped, perpetrators apprehended and sentenced



Warminsko-Mazurskie Association for Security

Gained recognition in the eyes of the public

Beame a credible and effective partner in the eyes of law enforcement and the judiciary

Inspired and supported other associations in Poland struggling with similar problems

Organised a series of conferences and trainings in cooperation with various partners, e.g. the University of Warmia and Mazury on kidnapping for ransom

Promoted the idea of security among the inhabitants of the region and active steps to increase their feeling of security



shooting training kidnapping for ransom






